







Arrange all parts and hardware to begin assembling the Swim Platform.




STEP 2

Mount the Swim Platform onto the Handle Bar and Platform Supports.


Use the provided bumpers to mount the swim platform onto the frame.



STEP 3


Tighten all nuts prior to mounting to transom.






ATTENTION

Do not mount swim platform before marking install location with Lead Rigger/Shop Foreman.











Mark top hand rail mounting location and confirm with Lead Rigger/Shop Foreman. Do not mark hole location inside of the side wall.


NOTE

Handrail mounting hole location is boat specific. Ensure the hole is close to the side wall and will accommodate the Bolt & Washer from the interior to bolt railing in place. If there is no side wall, ensure the Swim Platform does not extend past the transom (hatched area).




STEP 2

Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a pilot hole through the transom ensuring the hole is accessible from the inside of the Stern for Through Bolt access (B4).








Mount the swim platform onto the Hull and bolt the Hand Rail in place using the supplied hardware.

STEP 4

With the assistance of a Lead Rigger/Shop Foreman, mark the remaining mounting locations of the Swim Platform.

Remove the Swim Platform to continue installation.



STEP 5


Read below attention before proceeding with step 5 Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a pilot hole through the upper left marked hole of the transom ensuring the hole is accessible from the inside of the stern for through bolt access (B4).


Ensure no cords or fuel separator are at risk of being drilled into. Some models will require carpeting/flotation foam to be removed before drilling into the hull.


For F17 & F19 Pro Boats, using a 1/4" drill bit drill a pilot hole through the aluminum Hull only, to accommodate the Screw (S1).








Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill a pilot hole only through the Aluminum of the Hull to accommodate the Wood Screw (S1).




STEP 7

Using a 25/64" drill bit, drill a pilot hole approximately 2" into the aluminum Hull to accommodate the Rivet Nut (N2).



STEP 8

Using a Nutsert Gun, insert the Nut into the bottom pilot hole and install in place (N2).



Install the swim platform onto the Transom using the previously drilled pilot holes.

- **A.** Mount the swim platform onto the Transom and bolt the Hand Rail and Platform Support using the supplied hardware.
- **B.** Screw in the bottom Hand Rail using the *(S1)* Wood Screw.
- **C.** Bolt the bottom Platform Support into the Rivet Nut using the *(B5)* Bolt.


ATTENTION

Silicone all hardware before tightening to prevent any water damage.






Do not mount swim platform before marking install location with Lead Rigger/Shop Foreman.
